

ENEMY FOOD

The average supply of these food-stuffs from Holland to England during the first six months of this year was less than 100 tons per week, whereas the average supply to *Germany* from Holland during the same period was over **4,000** tons (8,960,000 lbs.) per week, more than 1-lb. per head for the whole of the German Army.

Holland would also send her Margarine to Germany if the raw material (nuts) did not have to cross the sea where the British Fleet rules supreme. These nuts yield feeding cake for cattle, as well as oil for making Margarine. Dutch cattle fed on these cakes produce the butter, cheese and meat sent to Germany.


